ORDER:

The State of Andhra Pradesh enacted "Andhra Pradesh Scheduled Castes Sub Plan and Tribal Sub Plan (Planning, Allocation and Utilization of financial Resources) Act No.1 of 2013" to ensure, accelerated development of Scheduled castes (SCs) and Scheduled Tribes (STs) with emphasis on achieving quality focusing on economic, educational and human development.

2. In pursuance of the above objective and to provide quality residential education to the ST students in the State, the Government has decided to convert all TW Hostels in the State into Residential Schools in a phased manner.

3. As part of socio economic development of Scheduled Tribes in the State Tribal Welfare Department has been focusing on development of education among STs since education creates awareness, accelerates development and provides opportunity for suitable employment for a self reliant and dignified way of life.

4. Government of Andhra Pradesh has been implementing various developmental programs for the welfare of Scheduled Tribes in the state of Andhra Pradesh. A detailed review cum orientation work shop has been held by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh on 24.3.2016. The public representatives from scheduled castes and scheduled tribes along with the departmental staff and field staff have participated in the said work shop. The work shop has discussed to implementation of various programs thread ware and has come up with various recommendations for improving the efficacy of the programs and effective and timely delivery of services.

5. One such recommendation is to "Convert all TW Hostels into Residential Schools in the next academic year i.e., 2016-17."

6. After carefully examining the proposals furnished by the Director, Tribal Welfare and also in compliance to the Policy of the State Government to provide quality and residential education for all ST students, sanction has been accorded for converting (30) TW Hostels into Ashram Schools in ITDA districts and (84) Hostels into (30) Residential schools in Plain area districts during the academic year 2015-16 in addition to (50) Residential schools already sanctioned.

7. There are (134) TW Hostels located in the districts of Krishna, Guntur, Prakasam, Nellore, Chittoor, kadapa, Kurnool and Anantapur and Government have Issued orders for converting them into (80) TW Residential Schools as per the reference 2nd read above.

8. Out of the proposed (80) TW Residential Schools, Government have already sanctioned teaching and non-teaching posts for (50) TW Residential Schools vide reference 1st read above.

9. Vide reference 3rd read above, converting the balance TW Hostels in Non-Scheduled areas into (30) TW Residential Schools and sanctioning of teaching and non-teaching staff posts is being examined at Government level.

10. Vide reference 5th read above orders were issued effecting promotions to the posts of Principal to the (50) newly sanctioned Residential Schools.

11. The Principals of (50) newly sanctioned Residential Schools should report to the DTWOs immediately and the following action is to be taken.

a) A team has to be constituted for each Residential School with the following members.

Principal of the Res. School	Team leader
HWOs of the Hostels

ATWO	Member-convenor

Visit and finding out the requirement:

b) The above team shall visit the location of the hostel where the Res. School is sanctioned and find out whether the existing accommodation and availability of land etc., are sufficient and if not sufficient report the requirement.

c) For reporting the requirement, the check point report of the institution is communicated herewith for the reference of the team.

d) If, the TW Residential Institution is having land less than 1 ac. The Team shall meet the MRO concerned and find out the availability of suitable land locally. If

suitable land is not available locally, find out the land in the same mandal (or) in the same constituency and report the Survey number and location of the land immediately.

Planning for the enrollment:

- e) Further they shall find out the availability of tribal students in the existing hostels for enrollment in classes 3rd to 5th in the newly sanctioned Residential School. If, the number is less than (120), i.e., less than (40) per each class, then the Team shall have to identify the ST students from out of the day scholars from the nearby villages. For this they have to use the data of ST students available with MEOs concerned.

Planning for shifting the higher class students:

- f) With regard to the students studying from class 6 to class 9 during 2015-16 necessary action shall be taken to admit them in the nearby TW Ashram Upper Primary School / Ashram High School / TW Residential School / Mini Gurukulams / KGBVs / Model Schools as per the choice of the student for their studies during 2016-17.
- g) In this process care shall be taken to ensure that no student drops out.
- h) However, if the student would like to continue in the hostel studying in the school where he/she is studying at present may be continued in the same school during 2016-17 also. He/she shall be continued in the converted hostel as a boarder during 2016-17.

Planning for the hostel workers:

- i) Each Residential School shall have (6) Class-IV workers (2-cooks, 2 kitchen helpers, 1-watchman & 1-sweeper) & (7) workers in girls institution with 1 Ayah additionally). In the first year, i.e., during 2016-17 (4) workers are required urgently. The DTWO has to provide (4) workers in each Residential School by way of redeploying from hostels having lesser strength. They have to issue proceedings to that effect duly marking copy to this office.
- j) The Salaries of the HWOs and Workers, and expenditure on diet and other contingencies shall have to be met under regular budget as explained in G.O.Ms.No.17, Finance (HR-III)Dept., dt:05.02.2016 (copy enclosed).

Role of the Hostel Welfare Officer:

- k) The Hostel Welfare Officers of the hostels which are now converted into Residential Schools shall continue to be Hostel Welfare Officers only.
- l) The HWO of the hostel where the Residential School is opened shall continue as HWO of the hostel section of the Residential School as clearly explained in the G.O.Ms.No.17, Finance (HR-III) Dept., dt:05.02.2016.

- m) The HWO of the hostel which is now going to be merged in the Residential School shall also continue as the HWO of the same hostel for the higher classes children.
- n) However, the entire situation will be critically reviewed in August, 2016.
- o) The department is also contemplating to adjust the HWOs of the merged hostels against the existing (208) vacancies of HWOs of pre-matric and post-matric hostels.
12. There shall be a meeting with the Teams in the last week of May, 2016, to review the action taken. Dates and venue will be informed subsequently.
13. The Dist. Tribal Welfare Officers of concerned districts are hereby instructed to take necessary action accordingly and report compliance to this office immediately.
14. The Principals of TW Residential Schools shall acknowledge the receipt of the proceedings and report compliance immediately.
